

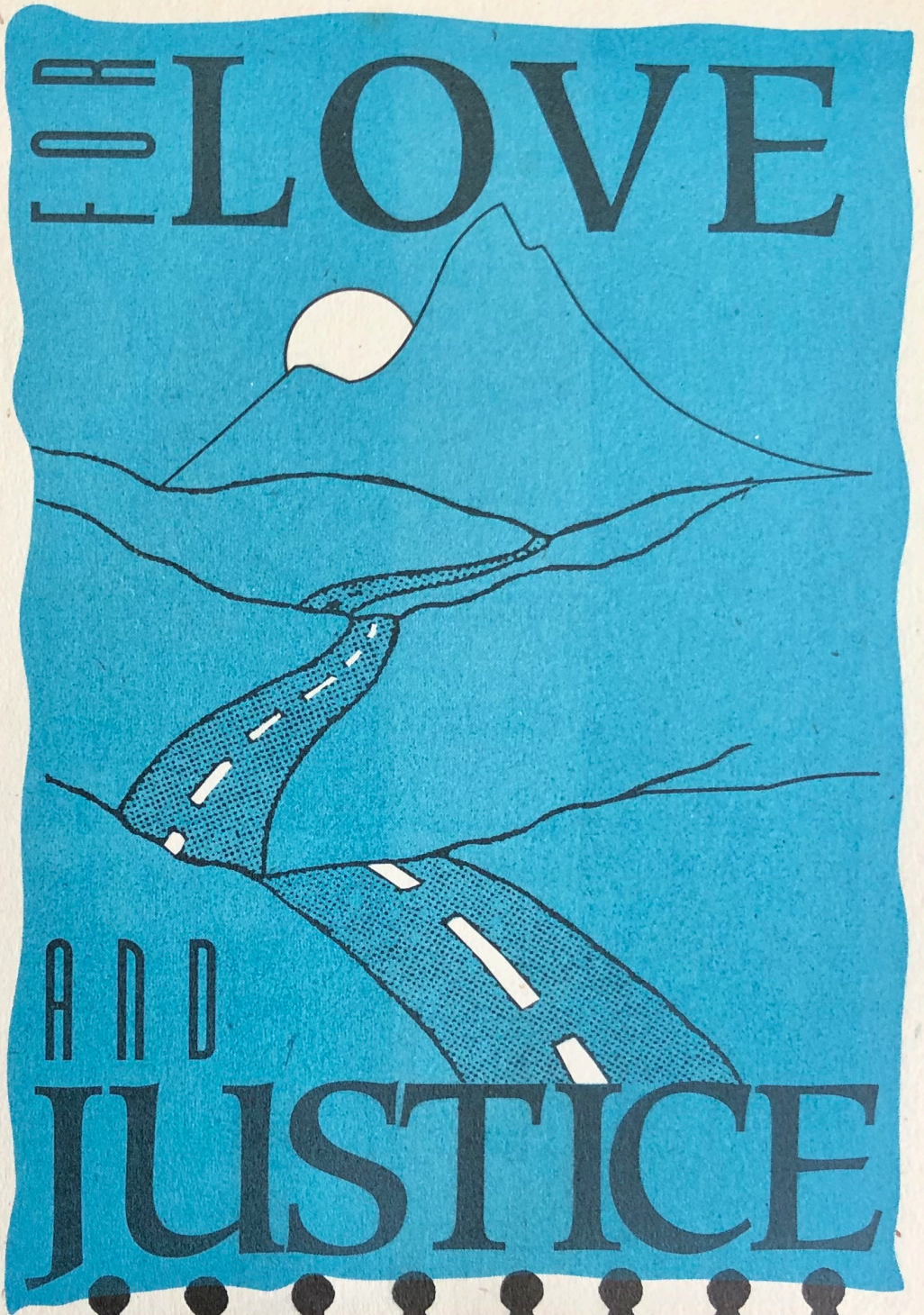

# FOR LOVE AND JUSTICE - A WALK AGAINST HATE

The fundamental rights of lesbians and gays are under attack in Oregon by the OCA, a right-wing organization whose agenda, we believe, also threatens the rights of women, Jews, people of color, and the poor. We invite all people who believe in justice and freedom to unite to fight this bigotry.

On June 7, 1992, hundreds of people—including lesbians, gay men, bisexuals, friends, families, and allies—will begin a 150-mile, two-week walk from Eugene to Portland, ending June 20.



## CARAVANS

■ Car caravans from all over the state will converge in Eugene for the start of the walk on June 7.

## THE WALK

■ We will walk an average of 11 miles per day, stopping for breaks, lunch, and snacks. Our route takes us north from Eugene on 99W through Corvallis and Salem, and on 99E through Woodburn, Oregon City and Milwaukie. The walk will end at the Lesbian/Gay Pride Parade in Portland on June 20.

## LODGING

■ We will be hosted by churches, synagogues, union halls, and other organizations where we will sleep indoors, usually on the floor in sleeping bags.

## FOOD

■ We will be fed by local community and church groups, supportive businesses, and progressive organizations.

## GEAR

■ Vehicles will carry our gear. All that walkers need to carry is what they need during the day.

## PROGRAMS

■ In the evenings we will sponsor programs in the local communities which will range from political discussions to musical entertainment and will deal with such subjects as homophobia, racism, sexism, democracy and civil rights.

## ENTERTAINMENT

■ Locally and nationally known entertainers will walk with us and inspire us with word and song.

## SAFETY

■ Security will be prioritized because of the climate of hatred and fear fueled by the OCA campaign. We will be working with local and state police, as well as training our own security team to promote the safety of all participants. For this reason we must ask that children **not** participate in the walk. We welcome all people over the age of 18.

## HEALTH CARE

■ Volunteer health care workers will be on hand for first aid needs, and a team of massage therapists will be available for on-site sports massage.

## MONEY

■ We are asking that each participant raise pledge money to be collected in full before the start of the walk. For walkers going the whole way, we ask for a minimum of \$300 in sponsorship, and for those walking one day or more, we ask for \$50 minimum sponsorship per day. This money will cover the cost of the walk, with proceeds going towards work against homophobia around the state. We will assist the fundraising efforts of those not able to raise the full amount.

## ACCESSIBILITY

■ We welcome participants of all abilities. Most days will be wheelchair accessible, and vans will be available to pick up walkers unable to go the full distance.

Join **FOR LOVE AND JUSTICE—A WALK AGAINST HATE**. We will walk proudly and with purpose—taking the agenda out of the hands of the OCA and going directly to the people of Oregon, asking them to stand with us for justice and against bigotry.

Bring your talent, your sense of humor, your courage, and your walking shoes for two weeks of adventure, walking to create a safe, just, and compassionate Oregon.
